- An Lompa Loompa (-Charlie and the Chocolate Factory)- orange facepaint, green hair and dungarees.
- Miss Spider (James and the Giant Peach)- black trousers/ leggings and a t-shirt and legs made out of black tights stuffed with newspaper.

If you're really struggling, your child could just wear yellow, which was Roald Dahl's favourite colour.
